

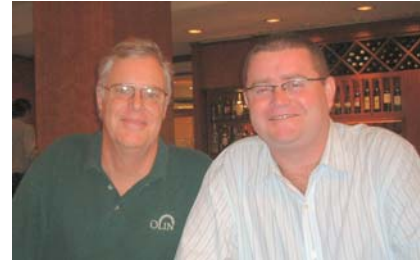

IAEM Is U.S. Contact for CIEA in Beijing

IAEM is the U.S. contact for those interested in exhibiting at the [2007 China \(Beijing\) International Emergency Assistance \(CIEA\) Expo & Forum](#), Sept. 12-14, in Beijing, China.

This is the first exclusive event in the field of emergency assistance supported by the government in China. Anticipated attendance is 8,000-10,000, with 150 exhibitors.

The Chinese safety and security market has exceeded US\$10 billion, with expected growth as high as 20 percent per year. Industry experts estimate that by 2020 China's EM industry will reach US\$30 billion.

As market demand continues to grow rapidly, China has expanded from its traditional base in the financial, customs, police and airport sectors to the construction, transportation and education fields.

IAEM will assist all U.S. participants with show procedures, including obtaining visas and

arranging for travel to Beijing. Participants can take advantage of the following:

■ IAEM will organize a U.S. pavilion – a turnkey package that will include your fully-fitted booth, interpreter services, translation assistance and on-site support. Cost is estimated at \$3,500-\$4,000.

IAEM Call for Officer Nominations

IAEM will elect new officers at its 2007 Annual Conference & EMEX Exhibit in Reno, Nevada. Candidates for Second Vice President and Treasurer must submit credentials by **Sept. 1, 2007** to IAEM Headquarters.

To be placed on the ballot, all candidates must submit: a letter stating candidacy; a letter of permission from the immediate supervisor supporting the time and travel necessary to fulfill duties of office; a brief resume; and confirmation of membership of at least three consecutive years immediately prior to seeking office.

Individual members are eligible to hold national office, provided they have been a member for at least three consecutive years and have served as a regional or national officer, national committee chair or active national committee member for two consecutive years.
